



**AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION**  
**SUBSCRIPTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS**

In consideration of the mutual covenants, terms, and conditions set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, you (“Subscriber”) are entering into an AMA Guides® Digital Individual Subscription Agreement (“Subscription Agreement”) with American Medical Association, a not-for-profit corporation, located at AMA Plaza, 330 N. Wabash Ave., Suite 39300, Chicago, Illinois 60611-5885 (the “AMA”), as follows:

**1) Rights and Licenses.**

- A. AMA Guides. Subject to the terms and conditions of the Subscription Agreement, including, but not limited to, the display and use requirements and restrictions set forth in this Section 1, AMA hereby grants Subscriber a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferrable, non-sublicensable license to access and use AMA Guides Digital Content.
- B. Ownership. As between AMA and Subscriber, AMA owns all right, title and interest in and to the AMA Guides Digital Content, including all intellectual property rights therein. Upon termination of this Subscription Agreement, Subscriber’s right to access AMA Guides Digital Content shall immediately terminate. For the avoidance of doubt, at no point does Subscriber gain any ownership interest in the AMA Guides Digital Content by virtue of this License.
- C. Access to AMA Guides Digital Content. Subscriber may only access AMA Guides Digital Content directly via AMA’s website available at [<http://ama-guides.ama-assn.org>].
- D. Subscriber ID. Subscribers must have or create an AMA account in order to purchase a subscription, and this AMA Sign On will act as a unique identifier specific to Subscriber (a “**Subscriber ID**”). Subscriber must use this Subscriber ID in order to access the AMA Guides Digital Content. Subscriber may not share this Subscriber ID, and is responsible for the confidentiality of such Subscriber ID. Subscriber shall be liable for any unauthorized use of the AMA Guides Digital Content by Subscriber or any third party who has gained access to Subscriber’s Subscriber ID.
- E. Permitted Uses. Since Subscriber has selected an individual subscription license, Subscriber shall be permitted to:
  - i. Search, view, retrieve and bookmark the AMA Guides Digital Content;
  - ii. Print a single copy of de minimis portions of the Digital Content for personal use;
  - iii. Download or store a copy of portions of the Digital Content for individual archival purposes only, as long as your subscription remains in good standing;
  - iv. Transmit a single electronic copy of individual Guides Newsletters articles, or discrete items or limited portions of a single chapter, in connection with personal, scholarly review of Digital Guides content.
- F. Prohibited Use. Subscriber is strictly prohibited from:
  - i. Copying, sharing, modifying, obscuring or altering the AMA Guides Digital Content to which it is provided access;
  - ii. Attempting to create a substitute or similar product through use of or access to theAMA Guides Digital Content;

- iii. Reselling, publishing, distributing, copying or otherwise using or transmitting AMA Guides Digital Content to any third party except as expressly permitted hereunder or otherwise by AMA in a separate writing;
- iv. Use AMA Guides Digital Content for any purpose other than permitted.
- v. The parties acknowledge that to the extent that the AMA Guides Digital Content is changed, such modification shall constitute a derivative work owned by the AMA. Subscriber assigns to the AMA any and all rights including copyright it may have in any derivative work of AMA Guides Digital Content and the intellectual property rights related thereon. Subscriber acknowledges that between the AMA and Subscriber, the AMA holds moral rights (e.g., the right to be identified as author) in the AMA Guides Digital Content;
- vi. Physicians conducting impairment evaluations, however, are permitted to engage in de minimis copying and pasting of Guides Content for the sole purpose of completing impairment ratings reports of impaired persons they are asked to evaluate.
- vii. Engaging in any Prohibited Use, without first requesting and obtaining an express written grant of Permission from AMA. Requests should be directed to [amaguides@ama-assn.org](mailto:amaguides@ama-assn.org).

## 2) Consideration

- A. Consideration. The subscription fees paid for Subscriber's access to AMA Guides Digital Content vary depending on the type of access and duration purchased ("Subscription Fees"). Depending on the AMA Guides Digital Content subscription service purchased, Subscriber's order shall be specified via online, phone or paper orders. Subscriber may be asked to provide AMA with a credit card number, which (if provided) AMA is hereby authorized to charge for Subscriber's payment of Subscription Fees hereunder as they are incurred. AMA may increase its Subscription Fees to Subscriber at any time, provided that such increases shall not affect the rates of any Subscriber subscriptions to the AMA Guides Digital Content in effect at the time of such increase, but may affect any subsequent subscriptions thereafter. All payments made hereunder are non-refundable.
- B. Costs and Expenses; Taxes. All Subscription Fees quoted are exclusive of any and all taxes, fees, duties, tariffs or charges which may be imposed in connection with payments made hereunder.

## 3) Warranty and Disclaimer

- A. Warranty. Subscriber represents and warrants that:
  - i. It shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, including with respect to data privacy, in performing its obligations and exercising its rights under the Subscription Agreement;
  - ii. It shall provide complete and accurate information to AMA in order to improve the accuracy of AMA Guides Digital Content and AMA Guides Digital Content usage;
  - iii. Its use of [ama-guides.ama-assn.org](http://ama-guides.ama-assn.org) is and shall at all times be solely for the Purpose stated in this Subscription Agreement;

- B. Warranty Disclaimer. The AMA Guides Digital Content and access to the AMA Guides Digital Content are provided “AS IS,” without warranty of any kind. AMA expressly disclaims any and all warranties, whether express or implied, or statutory, under the Subscription Agreement or otherwise with respect to the AMA Guides Digital Content, including, without limitation, any warranties of merchantability, design, title, non-infringement, and fitness for a particular purpose. AMA does not warrant as to the quality, accuracy or completeness of the AMA Guides Digital Content, nor does AMA warrant that the <http://ama-guides.ama-assn.org> will be uninterrupted or error free. Notices and alerts provided via AMA Guides Digital Content services, if any, are provided as informational only, and as supplemental to Subscriber’s own records monitoring tasks, and are made available at Subscriber’s own risk. AMA does not warrant as to the delivery, accuracy, timeliness or completeness of such notices or alerts provided via any of its AMA Guides Digital Content, and Subscriber should not rely on such notices and alerts.

#### 4) Limitation of Liability

- A. General. AMA shall not be liable to Subscriber, or any individual or entity claiming through or under Subscriber, for any loss of profit or income or for any consequential, incidental or special damages, whether in an action for contract or tort or in connection with the Subscription Agreement, even if AMA has been advised of the possibility of such damages.
- B. AMA Guides Digital Content. AMA shall not be liable for any damages, losses, liabilities or claims of any kind to the extent arising out of (i) the quality, accuracy or completeness of AMA Guides Digital Content, or (ii) the delivery (or lack thereof) of notices and alerts via by AMA.

#### 5) Term; Termination and Suspension

- A. Term. This Subscription Agreement shall remain in effect as to Subscriber for so long as Subscriber has permitted access to the AMA Guides Digital Content or <http://ama-guides.ama-assn.org>. Access duration shall depend on the type of service and duration selected by Subscriber. Unless otherwise permitted by AMA in writing, subscription based AMA Guides Digital Content access (and associated payment obligations) shall continue to renew for identical subsequent subscription terms unless terminated by Subscriber thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the then-current subscription term.
- B. Termination and Suspension. AMA may terminate or suspend, in AMA’s sole discretion, Subscriber’s access to the AMA Guides Digital Content immediately in the event Subscriber materially breaches or violates any provision of the Subscription Agreement. Further, if AMA terminates (i.e. discontinues) or suspends all or any AMA Guides Digital Content offered hereunder, Subscriber’s permitted access to such services shall be terminated or suspended as well. In the event AMA terminates Subscriber’s access to AMA Guides Digital Content hereunder without cause, AMA shall refund to Subscriber a pro-rated portion of Subscription Fees based on pre-paid amounts.
- C. Consequences of Termination. Upon termination of the Subscription Agreement, Subscriber’s access to the AMA Guides Digital Content and [ama-guides.ama-assn.org](http://ama-guides.ama-assn.org) shall be immediately terminated.

- D. Survival. Notwithstanding any termination or expiration of the Subscription Agreement, the provisions of Sections 3, 4 and 6 herein shall survive any expiration or termination of the Subscription Agreement.

**6) Miscellaneous**

- A. Governing Law. This Subscription Agreement and all matters regarding Subscriber's use of the AMA Guides Digital Content hereunder shall be governed by, construed in accordance with, and enforced under the laws of the State of Illinois applicable to contracts made and executed and wholly performed in the State of Illinois, without regard to choice of law principles. Neither the Uniform Computer Information Transaction Act nor the United Nations Convention on Contracts for International Sale of Goods applies and their applicability is expressly excluded. Printed copies of any and all agreements and/or notices in electronic form shall be admissible in any legal, investigative or regulatory proceedings.
- B. Statute of Limitations. Regardless of any statute or law to the contrary, any claim or cause of action arising out of or related to Subscriber's Use of the AMA Guides Digital Content must be filed by Subscriber within one (1) year after such claim or cause of action arose or be forever barred.
- C. Assignment. The Subscription Agreement may not be transferred or assigned by Subscriber without prior written consent of AMA, such consent not to be unreasonably delayed or withheld. For purposes of this provision, any change of control of Subscriber, whether by merger, acquisition, stock purchase or otherwise, shall be deemed an assignment. Any assignment in violation of the foregoing shall be null and void. The Subscription Agreement shall be binding on any permitted successors or assignees.
- D. Notices. All notices required or permitted under the Subscription Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed given when delivered in person or by email to Subscriber's email address on file with AMA, or five (5) days after being sent mail, postage prepaid and addressed to the addresses set forth above in the Subscription Agreement.
- E. Waiver and Severability. The failure of AMA to exercise or enforce any right or provision in the Subscription Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision. If any provision of the Subscription Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such provision shall be enforced to the fullest extent of the law, and all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- F. Entire Agreement; Modifications. This Subscription Agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content, and any order form Subscriber may execute for AMA Guides Digital Content which references this Subscription Agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content, represents the entire agreement between Subscriber and AMA and supersedes any prior or contemporaneous understandings or agreements with respect to Subscriber's access to and use of the AMA Guides Digital Content. Any terms or conditions in any order form for AMA Guides Digital Content in conflict with any terms or conditions herein shall be null and void unless specifically stated as taking precedence over this Subscription Agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content in such order form. AMA reserves the right to revise this Subscription Agreement

for AMA Guides Digital Content at any time in its sole discretion by posting a revised License agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content to the AMA website. Subscriber's access to and use of the AMA Guides Digital Content signifies Subscriber's acceptance of all the terms and conditions contained within the Subscription Agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content posted at the time of such access or use. Subscriber will be responsible for regularly reviewing this Subscription Agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content posted to the AMA website. No revision to this Subscription Agreement for AMA Guides Digital Content, including to the arbitration provision set forth in Section 6(A) shall apply to a controversy or claim of which the AMA had actual notice on or before the date of any such revision. The Subscription Agreement cannot be modified by Subscriber except in written form, signed by both the Subscriber and AMA.
